

Teamer overview:

This year the Accies and BATs Minis will be using Teamer to help the coaching teams to plan for training as well as tournaments. It was also make your life easier and more efficient.

Teamer is a free and easy to use platform that allows communication between the coaching teams and players / parents via web, email, SMS and mobile app.

Teamer registration

If you do not already have one, the first step will be to create a Teamer login. This login will be assigned to your email address and/or your mobile number. In Settings you will be able to optimise how you receive notifications. These can come through by email, by text or as an in-app communication. It is unlikely that you will want or need all three in activation at once. However, we would very strongly recommend that you get the app – it saves you having to wade through emails / text messages or log onto the website to remind yourself of arrangements for the coming weekend.

1. You will receive, by email and/or text, an invitation to join the Teamer teampage for ACCIES/BATS Px. This will include a temporary password;
2. Click through to confirm that you want to join this team and then login with your temporary password;
3. Finally you will be asked to update / set your own password as well as confirm / add login details such as phone number (if you wish).

Teamer Payments

We will also be using the Teamer Payments platform to facilitate electronic registration and payment of the annual subscription.

We need everyone to be registered by the end of August at the latest. You will complete and submit one electronic registration to cover all your children across P1 to P7, and make one electronic payment as the last step of that process. The steps are as follows:

1. You will receive a 'Payment Request' from Teamer by email / text / through the Teamer app;
2. This will invite you to select your registration preference (e.g. 2 x minis members plus 1 senior club member = £170); and then lead you to;
3. An electronic registration form to be completed and submitted;
4. Enter card details to make the payment.
